Social/Emotional Development

Children need a combination of intellectual skills, motivational qualities, and socio emotional skills to succeed in school.1 They must be able to understand the feelings of others, control their own feelings and behaviors, and get along with their peers and teachers. Children need to be able to cooperate, follow directions, demonstrate self-control, and "pay attention."

When children are young, the adults around them (parents, other adult caregivers, preschool teachers) are the most important influences on their social and emotional development. You can assist your child by the following: (NIEER)

- Ensure your child plays with other children at home.
- Establish acceptable behaviors.
- Require your child to sit down for certain periods of time.
- Promote "Tools For Triumph."
