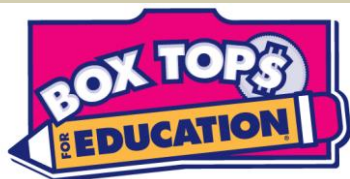
1. Set the example. Let your child see you reading at home.
